Grades 1-4

(\$.75 each)

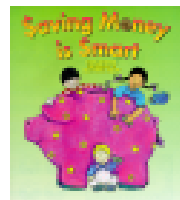
The lovable Peter Hound teaches children about opening a savings account, earning interest and making withdrawals. The activity book also provides examples of what to save for and how to save.

This bookmark will encourage kids to make the most of their money by saving and spending wisely. The informative design teaches that smart money choices always pay.

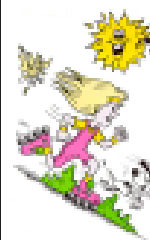
Coin Savers
