Learn how to protect your most important asset, your people. Your building, people, and layout are unique, so this session focuses on practical ways to improve safety without relying on unrealistic recommendations. Learn how to identify vulnerabilities and strengthen security within your existing environment.

1:00–2:30 pm Active Threats

Gain practical tools for active shooter and workplace violence preparedness, beginning with HSTG’s renowned **“Survival Gap” mindset training**. Explore how stress, perception, and human performance influence decision-making during sudden acts of violence and develop a deeper understanding of how mindset can directly impact survivability.

3:00–4:00 pm Interview vs. Interrogation

As the BSO, you may be required to conduct an employee interview. Learn how to build rapport, gain trust, create a theme, and obtain a confession. These critical communication skills can be used regularly, whether in workplace investigations or everyday conversations. While interviewing is one of the more challenging responsibilities of an investigator, the skills taught in this session are invaluable.
